



TULSA TRASH 2017 BY THE NUMBERS

Welcome to TARE's 2017 online annual report. This is our chance to show every Tulsa resident the impact of resource recovery and how everyone can play a part. Once you see the many ways we're working to reduce our impact on the environment, we think you'll agree there are some great things going on in Tulsa.

Here's 2017 at a glance:

RESIDENTIAL REFUSE

- > 103,463 tons of trash picked up
- > 13,955 loads hauled

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

- > 20,206 tons of recycling picked up

METALS RECYCLING

- > 796 white metals recycled
- > 66.15 tons were recycled

FREON RECOVERY

- > 5.57 pounds of freon were pulled from refrigerators

BULKY WASTE

- > 18,459 requests were made
- > 3.353 tons collected

WIN DUMPSTERS

- > 1,608 tons collected
- > 1,461 dumpsters set out

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

- > 1,997 electronic components were recycled
- > 66.23 tons processed

HHP FACILITY

- > 104,052 pounds of household pollutants collected
- > 1,995 customers were served
 - 1,600 Tulsa customers
 - 395 customers from surrounding communities
- > 54 pounds average per customer

MULCH SITE

- > 80,656 vehicles brought in green waste
 - 70,700 customers from Tulsa
 - 9,956 from surrounding communities
- > 379,009 cubic yards of mulch were ground
- > 9,065 vehicles picked up free mulch
- > 2,068 vehicles picked up free firewood

EXTRA REFUSE STICKERS

- > 23,700 extra refuse stickers were sold in 2017
